We go against the grain, which is working with the men who have been exploited for generations by being taught to fish sharks in exchange for their survival. Something they see no value in, but make the most money doing. What they make actually equals to and ends up just being pocket money to us. Meanwhile the sharks they catch, kill, and sell the fins of, end up being worth thousands of dollars once they make it to China, and they don't even know it.

Rather than demonize them, we approached them with an alternative. They join our team, we use their boats. We use their boats, they don't fish shark. They don't fish shark, but instead they now lead snorkel tours to some of the most beautiful and untouched reefs in Lombok, Indonesia. It's a win, win.

Our mission has and will always be to save sharks, however after meeting the men that we not only consider our crew but now, also our family. We now consider our number one mission being to hire as many boats as possible.

LENGTH

TYPICAL DAY AS AN INTERN

Activities Include (and are not limited to, and will vary):

- Day Trip operations running from 7am till 3pm (after long days such as this, the rest of the day is left to you to enjoy).
- Shop operations running from 10 am till 10pm (Some days will consist of being in the shop, whether to help with sales, organization of the store, merch, and more).
- Days with no scheduled trips can consist of local marketing, social media work, Island visits, exploration trips, and more.
- Off days can consist of visiting some popular surf beaches, planned intern trips around the island of Lombok, or spent relaxing.

Activities for Long-Terms Include:


- Management of Short-Term Interns & Employees

- Marketing and Social Media Development



WHAT DOES OUR INTERNSHIP INCLUDE?

Since we are a non-profit organization, those who join us on an internship are not only donating their time to come help us but also, all the costs for your internship are also seen as a donation. That being said, we are able to include some help and support during your internship.

VISA, FLIGHTS, ACCOMMODATIONS, & LOCATION

VISA Type: VOA (Visa On Arrival)

Visa On Arrival for Tourism is a Visit Stay Permit with a maximum period of 30 days which can be extended for a maximum of 1 extension for a period of 30 days at the Immigration Office. Thus equaling out to 60 days total.

Nationality Passport, & must valid and still valid for at least 6 (six) months.

A return ticket or ticket to continue the journey to another country.

Proof of payment of PNBP(receipt) for a visit visa upon arrival, in the case of applying for a Visit Visa on Special Arrival for Tourism. The applicable rate for a Visa On Arrival Special for Tourism is IDR. 500,000 / USD. 35 equivalent.

Flights, Accommodation & Location

Most international flights are capable of flying direct to Bali, meaning getting to Lombok will consist of booking a transfer flight. However, some flights flying into Jakarta are considerably cheaper, and from Jakarta you can also transfer to Lombok.

Once you've received your acceptance into our internship program, you will be given a list of reputable places that accept long-term accommodations, if you are choosing the long-term internship, within Kuta. Allowing you the ability to research and decide what you like best.

We are based in **Kuta, Lombok**. Lombok is the neighbouring Island right next to Bali.
